

## Roman Pelts

International Title: F.I.D.E. Master  
1983 F.I.D.E. Rating 2450

**R**OMAN PELTS is an accomplished F.I.D.E. Chess Master, professional chess coach and trainer. Mr. Pelts emigrated from the Soviet Union to Canada in 1978 and is currently a resident of Toronto.

Mr. Pelts was awarded the title of Honoured Chess Coach of the Ukrainian S.S.R. in 1970 for his successful training of International Grandmasters Lev Alburt and Vladimir Tukmakov, six Masters and more than 200 Expert players. His background also includes professional service as coach of the Russian Republic Team and the Soviet Union Students' Team.

Mr. Pelts brings to his Toronto Studio a wealth of experience, including his background of instruction at his first Canadian chess school in Montréal, Québec, where more than 300 students attended classes during the three year period from 1979 to 1981.

Mr. Pelts' personal results in Chess Tournaments include his representation on the Canadian National Team at the World Chess Olympiad at Lucerne, Switzerland in 1982. In 1978, he took 2nd place behind Hungarian Grandmaster Gyula Sax at the Canadian Open Chess Championship in Hamilton, Ontario. In 1964 he played on Board One for the U.S.S.R. Student Team at the Students' World Championship, where the team took first place and, as a team member, Mr. Pelts was awarded the Gold Medal.

Mr. Pelts has a Master's degree in Mechanical Engineering, and is a professional teacher. The Toronto chess community is indeed fortunate to have Mr. Pelts, with all his impressive credentials, in its midst. Furthermore, Mr. Pelts, as both Director and Instructor, is willing to share his experience and wisdom through the establishment of this, his latest venture: The Pelts Chess Studio and School, destined to become the finest institution of its kind in Toronto and throughout Canada.

More recently, Mr. Pelts coached Todd Southam of Toronto who, in 1983, at 13 years of age, took first place at the Canadian Cadet Championship for players 15 years old and under. As a result, Todd will represent Canada at the World Cadet Championship to be held in August 1983 in Bogotá, Colombia with Mr. Pelts travelling as his Second.



## FEE SCHEDULE 1983-1984

### Class Instruction

Lessons - 12 weeks  
(Maximum 6 Students per Class)

**Courses:** \$10. per hour

1 lesson per week - 2 Hours .....	\$240.
1 lesson per week - 1 Hour .....	\$120.
1 lesson per week - 1/2 Hour .....	\$ 60.

### Private Instruction

**Individual:** \$30. per hour.  
If 12 hours or more, the hourly rate is reduced to \$25. per hour.

**2 Students:** \$25. per hour, per Student.

If 12 hours or more, the hourly rate is reduced to \$20. per hour, per Student.

**3 Students:** \$20. per hour, per Student.

If 12 hours or more, the hourly rate is reduced to \$15. per hour, per Student.

### Family Discount:\*

If more than one member of a family attends, a family discount is available as follows:

- 1st Student pays Full Rate
- 2nd Student receives 20% Discount
- 3rd Student receives 50% Discount

\* Maximum Discount = 50%
